

MARIONVILLE CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

Wednesday November 3rd, 2021

Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program!

The City-wide clean-up is Wednesday November 3rd, 2021 and is only for Residential inside City of Marionville paying for Trash Services through the City Utilities, Any Item brought in from outside the city may result in a fine for dumping and will not be picked up and landowner will be responsible for disposal cost.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP

- * Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. the morning of Wednesday November 3rd for pick-up and are encouraged to put items out the night before.
- * **All small items must be bagged or boxed and not to exceed 50 lbs. No loose small items**
- * Any non-acceptable items that are included will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident.
- * Crews cannot access personal property to assist in moving items to the curb or from trailers
- * Clean-up **will not** take place at businesses, apartment buildings or at vacant homes

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture – Indoor/Outdoor**
 - Beds/Mattresses**
 - Table and chairs **
 - ** No more than 2 large Furniture items or mattresses per residents*
 - Large Children Toys/ Bikes
 - Hand and Power Tools
 - Toilet/ Sink
 - Televisions/Monitors
 - Grills - **NO Propane Tanks**
 - Microwaves
 - Weed Eaters / Power tools
 - Plastic cased dishwashers
- (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- NO Tires
- NO small Loose Items (Must be bagged or boxed.)
- NO Brush/Limbs/Yard Waste
- NO Hot Tubs
- NO Rocks, bricks, concrete
- NO Bulk Liquids
- NO Propane Tanks
- Fluorescent/CFL/HID Bulbs
- NO Batteries
- NO Appliances
- NO Hazardous Waste (including paint, oil, aerosol cans, fertilizers, etc.)
- No Vehicle / Large Engine Parts (Motors, Doors, Hoods, etc.)
- **NO Large remodel, Lumber or Shingles, Construction**
- NO small Loose Items (Must be bagged or boxed.)
